Dear Dr. Take,

On behalf of the Board of Trustees of Barrow Neurological Foundation (BNF), I am pleased to inform you that your FY24 project, **Impairment of efferocytosis promotes aneurysm rupture**, meets the requirements for innovative patient care, groundbreaking research, or state-of-the-art education and is being awarded funding. The award is approved for \$110,495.00 from donor-designated funds. This includes direct costs of \$84,996.00 and indirect costs of \$25,499.00. The award period is July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. All BNF awards are subject to the BNF Use of Funds Policy (see attached).

Research Administration will process the award; you will receive an official Grant Award Acceptance Agreement, which must be signed and returned according to the instructions provided with the agreement. For projects that need IRB approval, the IRB submission must be made by July 31, 2023.

You will work with Alicia Cybulski, BNF's Funds Manager, and Rachel Pinto, BNF's Project Manager, who will monitor the progress of the project along with your Program Manager/Supervisor on a minimum of a quarterly basis to ensure funds are being spent and the project is moving forward.

BNF requires two reports with a narrative on the impact of the funding and financial accounting of expenses for its Board of Trustees. The first will be a mid-year progress report due January 31, 2024. The final report will be due July 31, 2024, and must include a description of the project results and completion of the project's overall aims. Reminders will be sent by thirty days before the due dates.

Research projects may carry forward the awarded funds for one year. To qualify for carry forward, funds must remain, a demonstration of research progress but the need for continued work on the project, and submission of both reports (mid-year and final).

In all public acknowledgments, you must indicate Barrow Neurological Foundation funds this project. You may also be asked to participate in BNF public relations efforts, including presenting at BNF events and meetings, being featured on BNF social media channels, or participating in BNF digital and published content.
